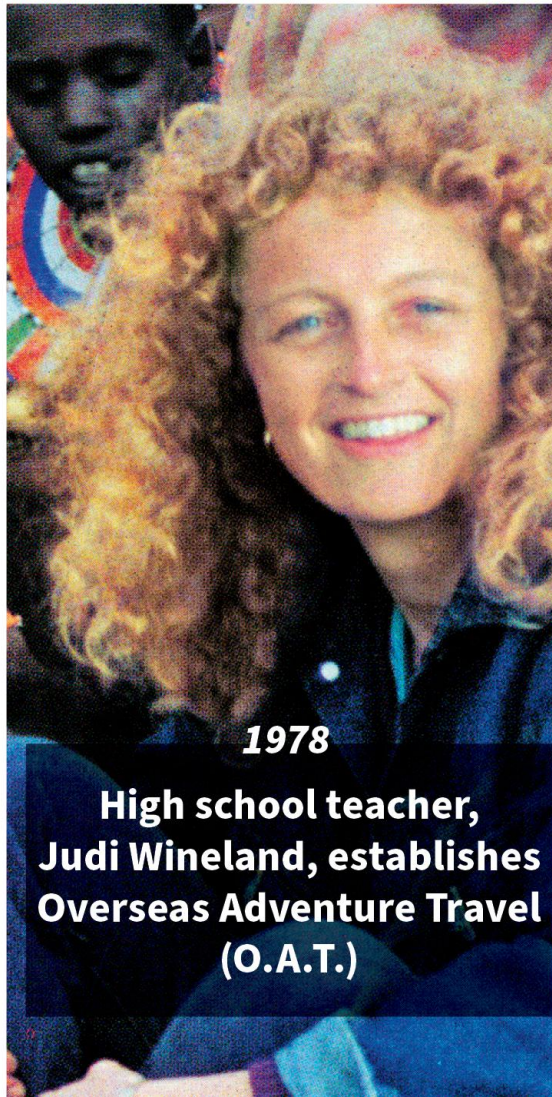

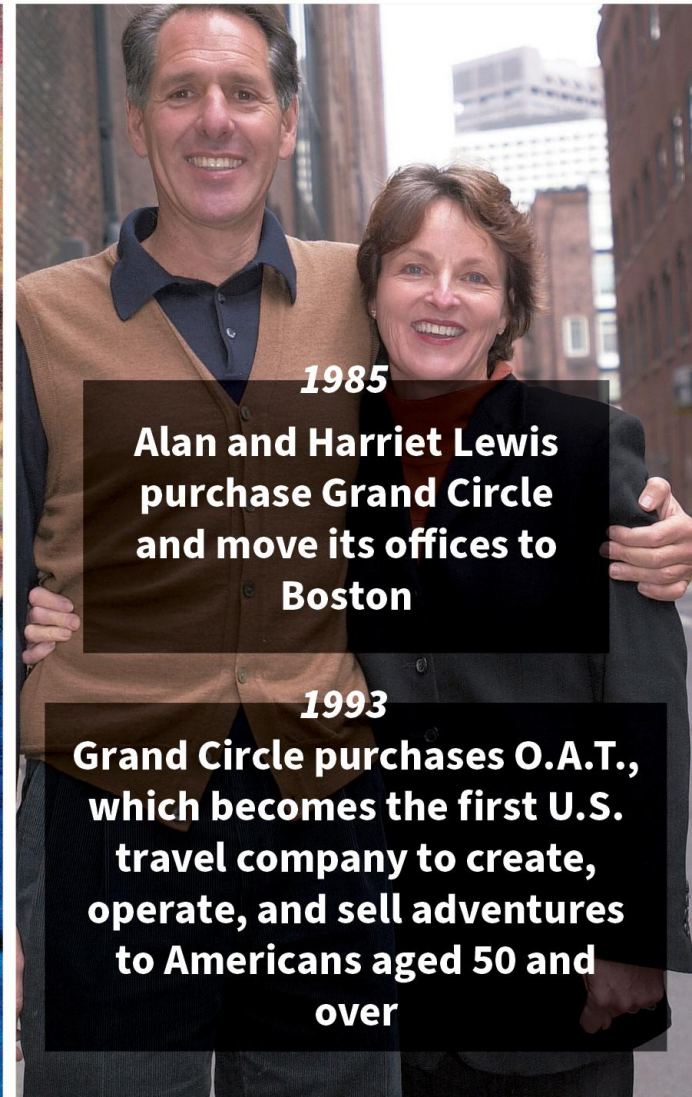
1958

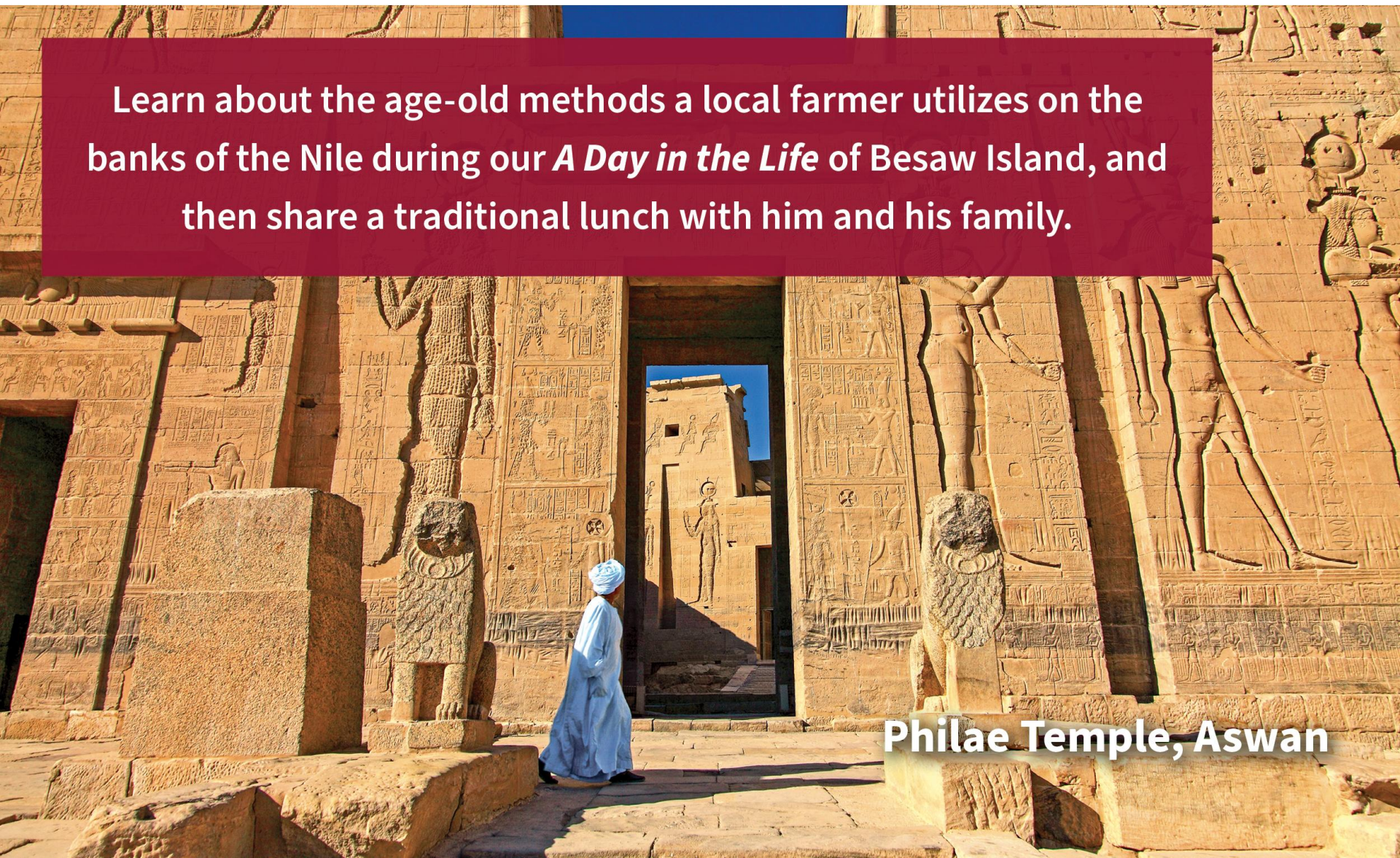
